## *Reports*

You will not find anything surprising there:

- part 1 = administrative things
- part 2 = list of the most important publications coming out the project
- part 3 = report: what did I/we want to do, what have been the goals, what did I/we achieve, who contributed to the success of the project. Is there a bachelor / diploma / master / phd / habilitation thesis related to the project? Maximum: 10 pages
- part 4 = summary maximum 1 page

Please note: the DFG has the right to publish the **summary** online (GEPRIS)

## Reports

YOUR reports are part of the final report of the SPP 1388, which consist of two parts:

- the scientific part = collection of all your reports of the individual projects and some introduction written by me and
- a report explaining the "additional value" of the existence of the priority program, *this is work for the speaker supported by the steering committee*, and
- a lot of statistical data: who got a phd, who got a junior professorship, who got a habilitation, who got a professorship.

I will write in September / October to all of you and would very much appreciate your help to collect the data

## Money

What does it mean that the SPP 1388 ends on March 31 2015?

For your individual project this does not change anything. Your project has started on a certain date and then runs for 1 year, 2 years or 3 years, depending on the project, and this is independent of the SPP 1388.

## Money

What does it mean that the SPP 1388 ends on March 31 2015?

Officially the SPP 1388 ends on March 31 2015, but we got an extension till **March 31 2016**.

So all the **coordinator's money** which is on this day = March 31 2016 still on the coordinator's account will go back to the DFG.

## *Spending the money*

### Networking and "the coordinator's" travel money

- The travel money is for networking inside Germany.
- NO travel money for conferences in Japan or the US or ...

But for our priority program we have a special agreement: may use travel money for exchange within the Anglo-Franco-German network

## Representation Theory Across the Channel

We can cover **Travel Costs** (**No Housing Costs**) for people from the nodes in Germany going to a meeting in France or the UK.

*Please, if you give a talk at the meeting, write the title on the reimbursement form.*

We can cover **Housing Costs** (**No Travel Costs**) for people from the UK or France, if they want to participate in a meeting taking place in Germany.

Person to contact in the UK: Radha Kessar (London)

Person to contact in France: Jean Michel (Paris)



If you invite a speaker to a conference / meeting / summer school....., then you can always pay for travel + housing costs, independent of the place the person comes from.

There are no restrictions for the travel money you got as a principle investigator for your individual project

## **How to get money for a meeting**

Send an informal letter (not only an email!)

Rough idea of the aim of the meeting

How many people you expect to participate

How much financial support you need:

travel money / housing costs

meetings do NOT need to be BIG

## **How to get money for a visitor**

Send an informal letter (not only email)

How much financial support you need:

lump sum: travel money + living costs approx. 2.000 - 2500 per  
month

## *Some duties*

Articles: please, put on EVERY article you<sup>1</sup> publish a footnote:

*partially supported by DFG-Schwerpunkt SP1388*

**Reason:** In your final report and the overall final report we will have to list publications which are connected in what ever sense to the priority program, so it is useful to put a corresponding remark also on the paper.
