The work of the Workshop will be organized in five morning sessions and four afternoon sessions. The talks start on Tuesday, 16 June, in the morning, and end on Saturday, 20 June, in the late afternoon. Thursday afternoon is free with organized excursion.

The Conference site is situated in the resort area extending to the north-east of Varna on the Black Sea Coast. Varna is Bulgaria's third largest city and
